FEDERAL STUDENT LOANS (U.S. CITIZENS AND ELIGIBLE NONCITIZEN ONLY)

As a Title IV participating school, Westminster Seminary California students who meet eligibility requirements and are enrolled in at least 6 credit hours per semester may borrow up to \$20,500 per academic year in the Stafford Federal Direct Student Loan Program to fund their educational costs (tuition, fees, and most living expenses). Some students may be eligible for additional loans through the Direct Grad PLUS Loan Program for Graduate/Professional Students. Students who wish to borrow must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and the WSC Application for Federal Stafford Loans every year they want to borrow. The FAFSA must be completed online at www.studentaid.gov. The WSC Title IV School Code is G22768.

Loans have a fixed interest rate that is set annually by Congress. Repayment is deferred during full and half-time enrollment and for six months after graduation. Students who drop below half-time enrollment status will have a six-month grace period before repayment begins.

Note: Graduate students are not eligible for any (non-repayable) federal grant programs.
